## **Health Care Information System Rebuilt**

If you have visited the Hospital over the past several weeks, you may have noticed some delays in the registration process. These are due to a transition from our old Health Care Information System (HCIS) to one that has been rebuilt with improved functionality and integration.

The reason for this move from one system to another is the expansion of the North Eastern Ontario Network (NEON), which initially involved 7 corporations and now includes 13 corporations and 16 physical hospital locations across the province:

- Anson General Hospital, Iroquois Falls
- Bingham Memorial Hospital, Matheson
- Chapleau Health Services
- Englehart and District Hospital
- Hôpital régional de Sudbury Regional Hospital
- Kirkland and District Hospital
- Lady Dunn Health Centre, Wawa
- Lady Minto Hospital, Cochrane
- Northeast Mental Health Centre
- Smooth Rock Falls Hospital
- St. Joseph General Hospital – Elliott Lake
- Temiskaming Hospital
- Timmins and District Hospital

One of the goals of the partnership is the creation of an integrated patient record to allow for seamless delivery of healthcare throughout Northeastern Ontario.
